- a) Approve and authorize Chair to execute Amendment No.1 to the contract with Best Contracting Services, in the amount of \$12,518.00, for a total contract amount of \$177,981.00; and
- b) Approve the Notice of Completion.

Summary Text:

The existing roof had accelerated deterioration in the last few years, causing problems with continued leaks. The project ran smoothly and was completed on schedule in spite of three requested delays in the application of the new roof due to the noise and smells associated with the roof installation.

Background: On January 22nd, 2008 the County entered into a contract in the amount of \$165,463.00 with Best Contracting Services to provide labor and materials as specified to install a new retrofit roof system over the existing worn roof on the Santa Barbara County Administration Building located at 105 E. Anapamu St. in the City of Santa Barbara. The goal of the project was to provide a weather tight roof for the building without the cost of fully removing the existing roof system. The project was completed for a contract amount of \$ 177,981.00 which is inclusive of the original contact amount of \$ 165,463.00 plus the \$12,518.00 amendment.

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The amendment cost is 7 % of the contract amount and was caused by the need to move phases of the installation to after hours or weekend dates to minimize the impact of noise and odors on staff in the building during normal work hours.

Construction ran smoothly and the project was completed on schedule on May 29th 2008.

<u>Performance Measure:</u> The Notice of Completion will allow for the release of retention.
