That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve and authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for services related to enforcement of the California Nursery Inspection Program in the County of Santa Barbara for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 in the amount of \$19,100.00.
- B. Determine that the proposed action involves government funding mechanisms and/or fiscal activities and is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section CCR 15378(b)(4) and direct staff to file a notice of exemption.

**Summary Text:**

This item is on the agenda for the Board of Supervisors to review and execute an agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) to receive reimbursement for the County's Nursery Inspection program. Through this agreement, CDFA reimburses the Santa Barbara County Agricultural Commissioner's Office for the cost of activities that support this ongoing program to conduct annual inspections of licensed wholesale nurseries in Santa Barbara County to ensure they meet the State guidelines for general pest cleanliness and for freedom from pests of quarantine significance.

**Background:**

The Agricultural Commissioner’s Office has received funding for this purpose for many years per the California Food and Agricultural Code, Part 3, Chapters 1&2 of Division 4, commencing with section 6721. The funding for this program is anticipated to continue to provide reimbursement for our wholesale nursery inspection activities.
