- Compassionate Use Act (CUA) of 1996 Prop 215
 - Provides for Safe Access w/ Doctor's Recommendation
- Medical Marijuana Program (MMP) in 2003 SB 420
 - Allows Cooperatives/Collectives
 - Creates ID Card Program
- Attorney General's (AG) Guidelines in 2008
 - Provides Law Enforcement with Guidance
 - Defines and Guides Cooperative and Collective Operations
 - Refers to Storefront Dispensaries
- Recent Legislation: AB 1300
 - Reinforces Local Authority to Regulate and Enforce

Federal Law

- -Schedule 1 Controlled Substance
- Federal Prosecutors Enforcing Laws
 Concerning California Dispensaries

County Urgency Ordinance Background

Govt Code §65858 – Urgency Ordinance

- Two-Year Limit on Moratoriums
- County Moratorium enacted
 - Jan 2010 (45 days)
 - Feb 2010 Extended (10 mos. & 15 days)
 - Dec 2010 Extended (1 year)
- Current Moratorium Expires Dec 6, 2011

Dispensary History

Jan 2010: Four Storefronts Open

- Central Coast : Closed Zoning Enforcement
- Helping Hands: Closed Sheriff's Dept
- Miramar: Open Subject of Zoning Enforcement
- Green Room: Open

Intent of Ordinances

- Zoning Regulations Only
- Prohibit Dispensary Storefronts
 - Moratorium Only on Storefronts
- No affect on Non-Storefront Collectives and Cooperatives
