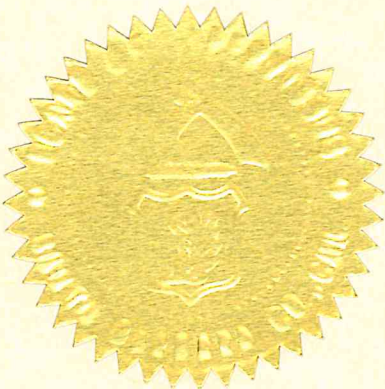
WHEREAS the Partnership for Resilient Communities was started by Gwyn Lurie and Joseph Cole, who are residents and strong community supporters of Montecito,





Passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County, State of California this 5th day of November, 2019 by a unanimous vote of all present.






Supervisor - 1st District




Supervisor - 2nd District



Supervisor - 3rd District




Supervisor - 4th District
