NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Resolution authorizes the District Attorney to accept and expend grant funds in the amount of \$96,373.00 from CalVCB for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 to continue this program subject to the execution of an amendment to Standard Agreement VC-9082 and acknowledgment of the terms and conditions contained therein; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney of the County of Santa Barbara is authorized to submit the attached amendment to Standard Agreement VC-9082 to CalVCB, and is authorized to execute on behalf of the Board of Supervisors the amendment to Standard Agreement VC-9082.


