Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Statement of Final Quantities for \$ 357,628.30 for work performed and materials supplied by Granite Construction for the Construction of the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Summerland Circulation and Improvement Project.

**Summary Text:**

The project consisted of improvements at two locations in the town of Summerland. The first location was at the intersection of Lillie Avenue and Greenwell Avenue, and the second was on Ortega Hill Road, from the northbound US 101 on-ramp, westerly through the "Summerland by the Sea" Mobile Home Park.

The project consisted of improvements to pedestrian, vehicular, and bicycle circulation by constructing 3,500 square feet of sidewalk and driveway improvements, installing five ADA compliant curb ramps, and installing 410 linear feet of curb and gutter. Parking improvements were made by changing from parallel to angled parking on the existing road right-of-way, and future planting areas were created as part of the project as well.

The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on April 28, 2010. The project was completed on time and on budget.

**Background:**

This project was the third phase of a multiphase project, and involved the construction of concrete curb, gutter, sidewalk, parking spaces, and planters within the existing road right of way.

On July 14, 2009, the Board of Supervisors approved and authorized the Director of Public Works to advertise the Construction of the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Summerland Circulation Improvement Project. This project received authorization to proceed with construction from Caltrans on August 10, 2009.

On January 5, 2010, the Board awarded the construction contract for this project to Granite Construction.
