- MOD 9 CDP requirement for new & expanded areas of cultivated agriculture and grazing
- MOD 9 CDP requirement for animal keeping
- MOD 9 School facilities allowed by CUP in agricultural zones
- MOD 9/13 CDP requirement for voluntary mergers
- MOD 10 Limitations on agricultural dwellings
- MOD 10 Certain residential accessory uses deemed not principal permitted uses
- MOD 21 Restrictions on private beach access stairways
