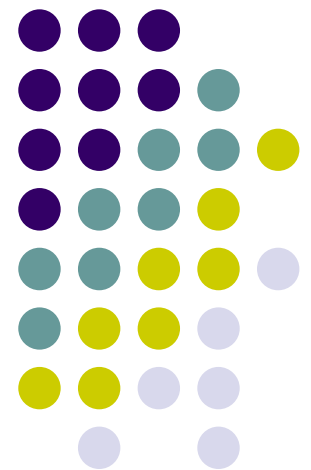

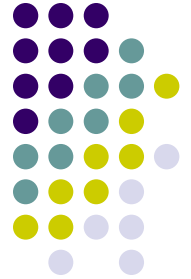

County Code Ordinance



- Sections 27000.1, 27000.7 & 27000.8 were added to Government Code in 1995, but not adopted in Santa Barbara County.

County Code Ordinance

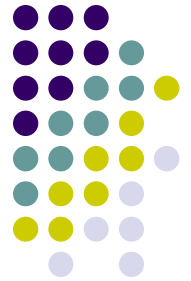


- Section 27000.1 ~ Delegate authority to the Treasurer-Tax Collector to invest or reinvest funds of the County. Effective for a one-year period and subject to annual renewal. A request will be made to the Board for the delegation of investment authority on an annual basis, along with the statement of Investment Policy.

County Code Ordinance



- Section 27000.7 ~ Eligibility criteria for election or appointment to the office of county treasurer-tax collector. One of the following criteria must be met: *(summary)*
 - Served in a senior financial management position in a county, city or other public agency for a least three years
 - Possession of a valid baccalaureate, masters, or doctoral degree in business administration, public administration, economics, finance, or accounting
 - Certified Public Accountant
 - Chartered Financial Analyst
 - Certified Cash Manager

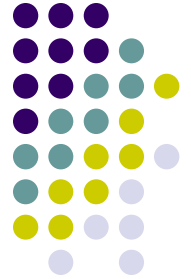
