WHEREAS, in 2002 a grassroots group of local Orcutt residents, employees, business owners and property owners got together and formed the **Old Town Orcutt Revitalization Association, OTORA**. They adopted the Orcutt Community Plan and adhered to the policies of the National Main Street Program for the preservation of historical towns across America, and;

WHEREAS, over the last nine years, working with Santa Barbara County OTORA has helped facilitate necessary zoning changes, design guidelines, a streetscape plan and with the support of the local community these projects are making Old Town Orcutt a unique one of a kind place, and;

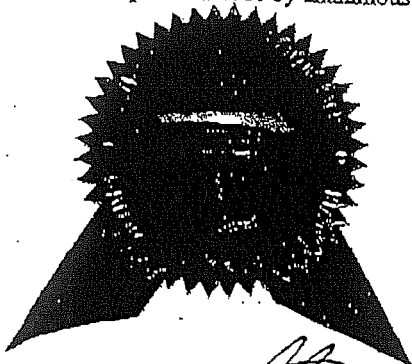

WHEREAS, OTORA'S latest project is to bring a 60 foot tall Veteran's Memorial Flag Pole to the entrance into Old Town Orcutt. A community center, live theater, a completed street-scape plan and a thriving living and shopping area are all planned for in the future by OTORA.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HERBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honor and recognize all the positive efforts and accomplishments of OTORA in revitalizing Old Town Orcutt.
