WHEREAS, Carol stabilized the Pharmacy Program soon after her arrival in 2001, and expanded the program by adding pharmacies into the Lompoc and Santa Maria Health Care Centers, and continuing the growth to include more than twenty contracted pharmacy locations; and

WHEREAS, Carol designed and implemented the innovative Project Impact: Diabetes, where she partnered with the health center physicians and dieticians to assist patients with accessing pharmaceuticals that they would otherwise not be able to afford and teach them how to use their mediations/medical devices, diet, and exercise to gain control of their diabetes; and

WHEREAS, Carol has been a mentor to countless Pharmacist Interns who learned from her the value of the Pharmacy 340B Program offering accessible pharmacy services and affordable medications to the health center patients for whom these medications would otherwise be unobtainable; and

WHEREAS, Carol has been an asset to our Public Health Department, the community and to her family and friends.
