WHEREAS the Santa Barbara County Public Health Department recognizes selected outstanding staff as Public Health Heroes and selected exceptional community partners as Public Health Champions for their commitment and dedication to protecting the health of our community by preventing disease and promoting health equity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County does hereby proclaim April 4 - 10, 2022 as National Public Health Week and encourages all residents in Santa Barbara County to observe this week by helping our families, friends, and lenders better understand the value of public health.
