WHEREAS, Sr. DPO Erdman received several accolades during his career, including: the 2006 CAPIA Meritorious Service Award for Line Staff, the 2011 Star Award, the 2011 Deputy Probation Officer of the Year Award, the 2016 Santa Barbara Citizens Council On Crime Superior Performance Award, as well as receiving letters of commendation in 2011 from Chief Probation Officer Patti Stewart for his work on a statewide special training project, and in 2013 from PSU Manager Brian Smith for his duties as Rangemaster; and

WHEREAS, Sr. DPO Erdman is looking forward to spending time with his wife Julie, travelling, spending more time practicing Karate and shooting sports, and continuing to teach self-defense classes at Santa Barbara City College.
