



## **Project Description**



#### **Background Information**

- 2003 Lot Line Adjustment, Rezone, and General Plan Amendment were approved, legalizing the lot and home in the existing configuration
- June 4, 2021 Coastal Development Permit for Accessory Dwelling Unit approved
- June 11, 2021 Appeal was filed to the County Planning Commission
- December 8, 2021 County Planning Commission denied the appeal
- December 15, 2021 Appeal of the County Planning Commission's decision to deny the appeal was filed

## **Appeal Issues Raised**

- Appeal Issue 1: The appellant asserts that there is inadequate access to the site and insufficient parking for the proposed development
- Issue 1 Response: There is sufficient parking and access for the existing development, and the ADU does not require additional parking spaces or access improvements
- Appeal Issue 2: The appellant asserts that the ADU will add to the applicant's vacation rental options
- Issue 2 Response: ADUs cannot be rented for short-term stays (nor has the
  applicant proposed this), must be rented out for a minimum of 30 consecutive days

#### **Appeal Issues Raised**

- Appeal Issue 3: The appellant asserts that the existing single-family dwelling is not legal at it's current square footage and violations exist on the subject property
- **Issue 3 Response:** The existing single-family dwelling was legalized through a Lot Line Adjustment (Case No. 00-LA-018 & 05MPC-5) and no violations exist on the subject property

#### **Recommended Actions**

- 1. Deny the appeal, Case No. 22APL-00000-00002
- 2. Make the required findings for approval of the project, including CEQA findings
- 3. Determine the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15303(a)
- 4. Grant *de novo* approval of the project, Case No. 21CDP-00000-00053, subject to the conditions of approval
