SUBJECT: Set Hearing to Adopt Resolution to Establish Solid Waste Tipping Fees and Parcel Fees for Fiscal Year 2022/23 - All Supervisorial Districts

Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

Set a public hearing for June 28, 2022 for 15 minutes to consider the following:

- a) Adopt a resolution, effective July 1, 2022, setting the fee schedule for solid waste handling and disposal at County facilities for Fiscal Year 2022/23;
- b) Adopt a resolution, effective July 1, 2022, setting the Parcel Fee Schedule for the Cuyama Valley for Fiscal Year 2022/23; and
- c) Determine that the proposed actions are for the establishment of solid waste handling and disposal fees charged by the County which are for the purpose of meeting operating expenses and financial reserves; that no expansion of services or facilities will result; that the proposed action is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR 15273(a) (1) (2) (3) & (4); and approve the filing of a Notice of Exemption on that basis.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda in order to set a hearing to adopt resolutions to establish solid waste tipping fees and parcel fees for Fiscal Year 2022/23. Each year, your Board adopts a resolution establishing fees charged at County-operated solid waste management facilities as well as setting the parcel fee schedule that is assessed to property owners in the New Cuyama Valley to pay for the operation of transfer stations in this rural community. These fees are developed and approved in accordance with Chapter 17 of the Santa Barbara County Code. A Board Letter will be submitted prior to the departmental hearing providing the proposed fee schedules for these services and will be available to the public on June 23, 2022 on the County Clerk of the Board's Website for the June 28, 2022 Board of Supervisors hearing. Hard copies will be available by June 23, 2022 at the Clerk of the Board's office at 105 East Anapamu Street, Santa Barbara as well as the offices of the Resource Recovery & Waste Management Division at 130 East Victoria Street, Suite 100 in Santa Barbara.

Performance Measure:

The tipping fees and parcel fees are based on the cost to provide these solid waste management services.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

There will be changes to the existing fee schedules and will be provided in detail in the subsequent Board Letter. There are no proposed facility impacts.
