**WHEREAS**, Assembly Bill 1276 (2021) Single-Use Foodware Accessories and Standard Condiments (AB 1276) intends to reduce the generation and disposal of single-use plastics in certain food facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, AB 1276 requires a city, county, or city and county, to authorize enforcement of AB 1276 in accordance with Public Resources Code section 42272.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Director of Santa Barbara County Public Works, or their designee, may enforce AB 1276, specifically Chapter 5.2 Single-Use Foodware Accessories and Condiments of Part 3 of Division 30 of Public Resources Code, within the unincorporated area of the County; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, enforcement shall be as provided in Public Resources Codes section 42772, where the first and second violations shall result in a notice of violation and any subsequent violation shall constitute an infraction punishable by a fine of twenty-five dollars for each day in violation, but not to exceed three hundred dollars annually; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this authorization is effective until rescinded by the Board of Supervisors.
