RESOLUTION NO. 2022-61

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA MARIA, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA TO CONSOLIDATE AND RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE CITY RELATED TO THE CONDUCT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2022

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Santa Maria called a General Municipal Election to be held on November 8, 2022, for the purpose of the election of one member of the City Council for District 3 and one member of the City Council for District 4 for a full term of four years each; and

WHEREAS, it is desired that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the City, the precincts, polling places, and election officers of the two elections be the same; and

WHEREAS, it is further desired that the County Election Division of the County of Santa Barbara canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA MARIA, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of §10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the purpose of the election of one member of the City Council for District 3 and one member of the City Council for District 4.

SECTION 2. That the County Election Division is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there was only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

SECTION 3. That the Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the County Election Division to take any and all steps necessary as prescribed by §10418 of the Elections Code for the holding of the consolidated election.

SECTION 4. That the County Election Division comply with the provisions of the Voter's Rights Act.

SECTION 5. That the City of Santa Maria recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for any costs.

SECTION 6. That the Chief Deputy City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the County Election Division of the County of Santa Barbara.

SECTION 7. That the Chief Deputy City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of Original Resolutions.

SECTION 8. That the Chief Deputy City Clerk is hereby authorized to make minor changes herein to address clerical errors, so long as substantial conformance of the intent of this document is maintained. In doing so, the Chief Deputy City Clerk shall consult with the City Manager and City Attorney concerning any changes deemed necessary.
