California Institute for Behavioral Health Solutions Amendment No. 1 to California Youth Opioid Response Services Contract

ARTICLE I AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT

Section 1.1 <u>Amendment and Restatement of Article I, Section 1</u>. <u>Article I, Section 1</u> of the Contract shall be amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

I. TERM AND TERMINATION

1) **Term**. The term of this Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and continue until the earlier of (a) <u>September 29, 2022</u>, or (b) termination of this Agreement pursuant to Section I (2) below (the "**Term**").

Except as expressly set forth herein, all of the terms and provisions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect and the Parties hereto make no other amendment, alteration or modification of the Contract nor do they, nor does any of them, by executing this Amendment, waive any provision of the Contract or any right that they or it may have thereunder.

Section 2.2 <u>Governing Law</u>. This Amendment shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California, without regard to principles of conflicts of law. Any suit or proceeding relating to this Amendment will be brought in the exclusive jurisdiction of the state or federal court in Sacramento, California. Each of the Parties consent to the exclusive personal jurisdiction and venue of such court.

Section 2.3. <u>Defined Terms</u>. Unless the context otherwise requires, capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meaning set forth in the Contract.

Section 2.3 <u>Counterparts</u>. This Amendment may be executed by each of the Parties hereto in one or more counterparts, each of which when executed shall be deemed to be an original but all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this Amendment in portable document format (.pdf), by DocuSign or other electronic format or by facsimile shall be as effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart of this Amendment.
