### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors accept and file the Certified Statement of the Results of the Official Canvass and Official Election Summary for the Statewide Direct Primary Election held on June 7, 2022, and declare elected those persons under its jurisdiction based on the certified results as required by law and as specified in the Declaration of Persons Elected.

#### **Summary Text:**

California Elections Code Section 15372 provides that the elections official shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the Statewide Direct Primary Election held on June 7, 2022 and submit it to the governing body within 30 days of the election.

The Clerk-Recorder-Assessor, in his capacity as ex-officio Registrar of Voters, sent the certified statement to the Board of Supervisors on June 28, 2022. California Elections Code Section 15400 provides the governing body (Board of Supervisors) shall declare elected those persons under its jurisdiction. The list of persons elected is attached.

California Elections Code Section 15620 allows any voter, within five days, but not later than 5:00 p.m. on the fifth day, following the completion of the canvass, to file a request for a recount with the county

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elections official of the votes cast for candidates for any office that is not voted on statewide. The "completion of the canvass" shall be presumed to be that time when the elections official signs the certified statement of the results of the election. As the signing of the certified statement occurred on June 28, 2022, the written request for a recount must be filed with the county elections official no later than 5:00 pm on Tuesday, July 5, 2022\*. The deadline for filing a written request for a recount has been posted on our website along with the certified results.

\*Deadline extended due to July 4, 2022 holiday.
