Approve, ratify, and authorize the Chair of the Board to sign and execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments (SBCAG) and the cities of Santa Barbara, Santa Maria, Lompoc, Goleta, Carpinteria, Guadalupe, Solvang, and Buellton to prepare a regional broadband strategic plan; and

B. Determine that the above actions are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), because pursuant to sections 15378(b)(4) and 15378(b)(5) the recommended actions consist of organization, administrative, or fiscal activities of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

Summary Text:

The Broadband Consortium of the Pacific Coast (BCPC) in coordination with REACH, the Northern Santa Barbara County Econ Alliance, local jurisdictions, and other key stakeholders have partnered to bring together stakeholder groups, higher education institutions and telecom providers to develop a long-term strategic plan for

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broadband deployment throughout Santa Barbara County. The County's approved contribution toward the strategic planning effort is \$200,000, set aside from ARPA allocations, and is to be distributed directly to SBCAG for administration of the program, approved by the Board on February 1, 2022. The attached Memorandum of Understanding outlines the roles and responsibilities of SBCAG and the local jurisdictions for preparing the broadband strategic plan. Under terms of the MOU, SBCAG entered into an agreement with the Economic Development Collaborative to develop the plan. This item recommends the Board sign the MOU with participating jurisdictions.

Background:

On September 21, 2021, staff brought forth a proposal for a Countywide Broadband Strategic Plan which included the County's participation in the development long-term strategic plan for broadband throughout the County. During the October 19, 2021 board meeting on ARPA fund allocations, the Board approved \$200,000 to be used toward a countywide broadband strategic plan. During the February 1, 2022 meeting, the Board approved a subrecipient agreement with SBCAG for the preparation of the broadband strategic plan. Work on the plan has been underway since January 2022.

Discussion:

On October 21, 2021 the SBCAG Board of Directors directed staff to coordinate with the eight cities in the county to request participation in a regional broadband strategic planning process and seek financial contribution to that effort. The SBCAG Board of Directors proposed dividing the remaining cost among the eight cities based on the 2021 Department of Finance (DOF) Population Estimate to the cities' population of 307,821. The total cost for this effort is \$400,000, which includes \$300,000 of direct costs with the Broadband Consortium Pacific Coast through the Economic Development Collaborative to develop the strategic plan, \$200,000 which is the County's contribution.
