Title: Appropriate ARPA funding for COVID-19 Direct Response Costs in Sheriff's Office

- Budget Action: Increase Appropriations of \$2,245,457 in Sheriff's Office General Fund for Salaries and Benefits (\$1,706,735) and Services and Supplies (\$538,722) funded by an operating transfer from the COVID-19 General Assistance Fund. Transfer appropriations of \$2,245,457 in County Executive Office COVID-19 General Assistance Fund from Services and Supplies to Other Financing Uses for COVID-19 Direct Response Costs.
- Justification: On October 19, 2021, the Board approved allocations of ARPA SLFRF funding, including for direct COVID-19 response costs that are eligible for reimbursement per U.S. Treasury guidance (up to \$7,596,480 in tranches 1 and 2). This BRR establishes appropriations and an operating transfer from dept. 990 utilizing ARPA SLFRF funds to reimburse the Sheriff's Office for expenses incurred in response to pandemic impacts, including costs related to vaccination, testing, PPE, and other COVID-19 mitigation and prevention strategies in congregate settings, totaling \$2,245,457. This departmental expenditure was anticipated under the "Direct COVID-19 Response Costs" category previously allocated within ARPA funding, and eligibility of expenditures is being validated by the County's ARPA SLFRF compliance and oversight consultant.
