We are the Santa Ynez Valley Community Outreach, we are set-up to help each of these populations. Meals on Wheels are targeted for seniors and veterans, but all our food programs benefit each population. We have programs that reach into Los Alamos and Lompoc, and the entire Santa Ynez Valley because they do not have all the programs we have so they have to travel to us or have us deliver food necessities to them. We have found that veteran's will not take food charity, so October 17th, 2022 we are opening a Veteran Food Pantry just for veterans.

We are seeking help for the Meals on Wheels program and the transportation program. We have doubled some of our programs since the pandemic. We are feeding 409 meals on wheels seniors and veterans five days a week. We are delivering to Los Alamos daily. Our produce program is filling the gap for the community to eat healthy and avoid food insecurities that would be devastating to seniors, homeless and families in our communities. Families are having trouble paying for gas to get to their jobs, they do not need the added burden of not enough food to feed their families.
