



CCCE's new energy-supply strategy will provide the following benefits:



Save on Electric Vehicles, E-Bikes and Chargers for Home and Work



#### **REDUCE EMISSIONS**

Transportation is the leading cause of greenhouse gas emissions on the Central Coast. More EVs on the road and greater access to chargers will accelerate EV adoption, reduce emissions, and help our region meet state and regional climate action goals.

#### **ELECTRIC TRANSPORTATION REBATES**

\$500 - \$4,000 in rebates available for purchase or lease of new or used electric vehicles, motorcycles, and e-bikes. Additional, stackable state and federal incentives available with up to \$15,000 available to income-qualified customers.

#### **EV CHARGER REBATES**

\$2,400 - \$10,000 available for Level 2 EV chargers at home or workplace; extra funds available for multiple vehicles and chargers for commercial customers and public agencies. Includes installation costs such as labor and electric panel updates or replacement.

#### **EQUITABLE ACCESS**

Electrify Your Ride supports underserved communities and low-income customers through targeted outreach, higher rebates, additional resources, and broader program eligibility.
