Summary Text: From time to time, the County has a need to engage outside counsel to assist the County and its elected officials with bankruptcy matters (such as the Venoco, LLC, ERG Resources, and HVI Cat Canyon, Inc. bankruptcies). This Amendment No. 1 extends the term of an existing outside counsel agreement to September 1, 2023. There is no change to the not-to-exceed amount of the agreement. The attorney primarily responsible for performing the bankruptcy legal services is Ross Spence.
