

⁽¹⁾ The estimated total construciton cost for the new buildings is based upon \$1200/sq. ft. for 0-30,000 sq. ft. in size and decreases to \$950/sq. ft. for square footage over 30,000.

⁽³⁾ In 2019, WGInc.com (Wantman Group, Inc.) states the median construction cost for a new parking structure was \$21,500 per space and \$64.77 per square foot, increasing 5.1% over 2018.



⁽²⁾ The BeWell Building includes the Psychiatric Health Facility, Crisis Stabilization Unit, Crisis Services, Sobering Center, Mental Health Clinic and Administration Offices
