WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the TDA, as amended, and pursuant to the applicable rules and regulations thereunder (21 CCR §§ 6600 et seq.) a prospective claimant wishing to receive an allocation from the Local Transportation fund or the State Transit Assistance Fund shall file its claim with the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the <u>County Public Works</u> <u>Director</u> is authorized to execute and file an appropriate claim and necessary claim amendments pursuant to applicable rules and regulations promulgated hereunder, together with all necessary supporting documents, with the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments for an allocation of TDA funds in FY 2022/2023;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the authorized claim include \$97,800 for SBCAG's regional transportation planning, \$427,400 for County transit and related work and \$141,716 for pedestrian and bicycle facilities, and \$2,650,000 for Santa Maria, Lompoc, Solvang, Guadalupe, SBCAG, and Santa Maria Organization of Transportation Helpers; a total claim amount of \$3,316,916; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments in conjunction with the filing of the claim.
