RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING SEPTEMBER 2022 NATIONAL RECOVERY MONTH IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara County Behavioral Wellness Department provides, in partnership with community-based organizations, a Continuum of Care which includes the prevention, intervention, treatment, and recovery from mental health and substance use challenges promoting the message that behavioral health is essential to wellness; and

WHEREAS, the Recovery Month theme, "Recovery is for Everyone: Every Person, Every Family, Every Community," celebrates all people that make the journey of recovery possible and spreads the message that people can and do recover every day; and

WHEREAS, Recovery Month promotes new evidence-based treatments for those battling addiction and focuses on recovery practices and the need for a strong recovery community with service providers who help people who are undergoing recovery. Through Recovery Month, people become aware and able to recognize the signs of mental health and substance use disorders and encourage people in need of recovery services to seek support and treatment, and


