Madam Chair and Supervisors,

CARP Growers is an association of 9 members operating 20 greenhouse cannabis farms in Carpinteria Valley. We ask that you please reject the appeal and approve of The Roots dispensary on Santa Claus Lane. Our members model best practices in greenhouse farming for a statewide cannabis market. Despite every effort to distinguish our farms as compliant, transparent and cooperative, the unregulated market still dominates cannabis sales. This is partly due to lack of access to dispensaries throughout the state which provide the only outlet for selling responsibly farmed cannabis from the Santa Barbara Coast.

As an association of responsible producers, we guard against operators who have not earned reputations for being best in class in this once stigmatized industry. The Roots applicants Mary and Pat Raidis live in Carpinteria Valley and own the location on Santa Claus Lane. They are as invested in the future of the community and Santa Claus Lane as anyone.
