SUBJECT: Sheriff's Office Salary Resolution Amendment Adding 7.0 Positions

Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Adopt changes to the salary resolution (Attachment A) to allocate six (6) full-time (1.0 FTE) Sheriff Service Technician and one (1) full-time (1.0 FTE) Community Resource Deputy (Sheriff's Deputy/Sheriff's Deputy Special Duty) positions to the Sheriff's Office, effective 11/28/2022;
- b) Approve the Budget Journal Entry No. #0008615, to increase appropriation of \$847,400 in Sheriff's General Fund for Salary & Benefits (\$747,400) and Other Financing Uses (\$100,000) funded by Intergovernmental Revenue-State (\$697,850) and an Operation Transfer from Capital Outlay Fund (\$149,550). Establish Appropriation of \$149,550 in Sheriff's Capital Outlay Fund for Other Financing Uses funded by a release of Committed Sheriff's Project Fund Balance; and
- c) Determine that these activities are exempt from California Environmental Quality Act review per CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4), since the recommended actions are government fiscal activities which do not involve commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.

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Summary Text:

Approval of the recommended actions would add six (6) additional Sheriff Service Technicians (SSTs) and one (1) Community Resource Deputy – Orcutt, classified as a Sheriff's Deputy/ Sheriff's Deputy Special Duty.

Background:

On October 18, 2022, the CEO's office provided a comprehensive report on Sheriff-Coroner overtime usage and costs, and proposed budget development policy for overtime mitigation, as well as an update on Proposition 172 funding. During the Board's deliberations the recommended actions were to fund six (6) additional Sheriff Service Technicians (SSTs) and one (1) Community Resource Deputy-Orcutt.

The SSTs positions will work closely with custody deputies to help offset structural staffing deficit in the Custody Operations Branch. The Community Resource Deputy would serve the communities of Orcutt and Los Alamos.

Narrative: On October 18, 2022, the Board approved the addition of 6 Sheriff's Service Technicians (SSTs), totaling \$648,000, using available ongoing Proposition 172 funds, to help alleviate overtime usage in the jails. Additionally, on October 18, 2022, the Board approved the addition of an Orcutt/Los Alamos Community Resource Deputy (CRD) to be funded 25% (\$49,850) from ongoing Proposition 172 funds and 75% (\$149,550) from the Orcutt Community Facilities District (CFD). This budget revision increases appropriations in the Sheriff's Office for the addition of 6 SSTs and 1 CRD, increases appropriations in the Sheriff's Office and General Services for the addition of 1 marked Sheriff Vehicle, and appropriates funding from Proposition 172 and the release of Fund Balance from the Sheriff's Capital Outlay Fund for the Orcutt CFD.
