Mobile Farmworker Resource Center

The work of the Farmworker Resource Center is envisioned to engage trusted community partners and also be largely performed by a subcontracted community partner, that would provide some in-person services and also make referrals to the appropriate service provider or agency, based on the need.

Services must be available in English, Spanish, and one indigenous language.



Fiscal Considerations



25% local match required: Total \$208,250 Funding source: Local General Fund or Other Federal Source



Grant is expenditure-driven. Local funds will be required until reimbursement can be received from State grant source.



15% maximum allowed for administrative/indirect expenses, not adquate for recovery of full indirect costs.



No State obligation to extend grant funding of \$833,000 beyond initial
14-month period of 2/14/23 to 5/15/24
