The book is called "The Story is in the Footnotes." Footnote One: "The Incessant Thoughts of a Tenacious Guinea Pig." Footnote Two: "Unapologetically Bipolar." My mission is to change how the world looks at mental health, using myself as my own damn Guinea pig. I will pursue this mission tirelessly, whether appointed to this Commission or not.
