






- Santa Barbara County is broadband ready







Local Agency Technical Assistance Grant Update

- Approved application process August
- •County application submitted in September for ≈\$500k

•Funding for a programmatic EIR

- •Funding for the development of high-level design analysis
- •SBCAG application submitted in September for ≈\$500k
 - •Funding for the formation of a Countywide Broadband JPA
- •CPUC ruling recognizes SBCAG as an MPO and therefore not eligible
- •Working collaboratively for a County resubmittal of \approx \$1m to implement
- broadband strategic plan and prepare for last mile funding
