Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute an Equipment Consignment Agreement with Quinn Company and to accept the highest public consignment sale offer to purchase surplus heavy equipment using the consignment sales process and to complete the transaction with a net consignment price of not less than \$53,100; and
- b) Determine pursuant to CEQA Guidelines §15378(b)(4) that the above fiscal activity is not a project subject to the California Environmental Quality Act.

Summary Text:

Section 2-47 of the Santa Barbara County Code requires approval from the Board of Supervisors before the disposal of surplus items with a market value in excess of \$25,000 by the Purchasing Manager.

The Santa Barbara County Fire Protection District intends to submit for public consignment sale one piece of surplus heavy equipment that has an estimated sale price of \$53,100 - \$59,000, and a net consignment price of not less than \$53,100. The item is identified as one (1) used 1985 Caterpillar Dozer D6D (serial #04X10531), with 4,636 hours.

Background:

The recommended action will allow the Fire Protection District to dispose of and sell surplus property valued in excess of \$25,000 that is past its useful life, and no longer needed by the department. The replacement bulldozer budgeted for this fiscal year was placed into service on November 26, 2022.
