### #12 Experience

I am interested in serving on this advisory committee because of my interest in and use of our county's walking and hiking trails. I regularly walk the trails near my home and the walk/hike trails at La Purisima Mission, Burton Mesa Preserve, Figueroa Mountain, and throughout the county. I have also hiked throughout California and other states. I enjoy everything from easy nature trails to more strenuous hikes in elevation. Through these experiences, I learned how important it is to have access to nature and outdoor activities for emotional, mental, and physical health. I want to facilitate the process of making these opportunities available to everyone in our county.

#### #13. Additional Information

Over two decades ago, I worked with the Lompoc City Council, Lompoc Parks and Recreation, and the youth in our community to raise awareness of the need for a skatepark. I also worked with the community, raising seed money for the project, and have continued to work with Lompoc Parks and Recreation, organizing skateboard competitions at the park annually. More recently, I have again been the liaison between the youth in the community and Lompoc Parks and Recreation, as a grant was pursued for a new skatepark.

In 2012, with the Lompoc Valley Chamber of Commerce, I began working with the small business community, organizing cash mobs and other promotional events to highlight the locally owned businesses. I also started educating the public about the importance of locally owned small businesses and how they impact our town's economy. I stepped down from this effort in 2017.

In the early 1990s, I, and another store owner, spearheaded an effort to repair the seating at Huyck Stadium. Through grants, fundraising and donations, we raised approximately \$120,000 for the repairs and then worked with Lompoc Unified School District to complete the project. A few years ago, I worked with LVCHO to help transition the memorial wall from our previous fundraising efforts and raise additional community funds when the stadium was updated.

I have also served on the Lompoc Libraries District Foundation, Lompoc Valley Chamber of Commerce, and Village Hills Basketball boards. I coached youth soccer and basketball and am currently a Lompoc Community Education Foundation board member.
