Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

a) Approve a Superseding Freeway Agreement on Route 101 from 0.7 mile south of Padaro Lane (PM 4.6) to Olive Mill Road (PM 10.5); and

b) Find that the recommended actions do not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR 15378 (b)(5) (Organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment).

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to authorize the Chair to execute a Superseding Freeway Agreement between the County and Caltrans for the US101 between 0.7 mile south of Padaro Lane (PM 4.6) and Olive Mill Road (PM 10.5). This agreement will modernize and replace agreements dating back to 1953 that do not reflect the current state of the infrastructure and related maintenance. The new agreement will consider the US101 widening project and associated parallel projects and allow for Freeway Agreements that delineate the various areas of responsibilities between the State and the County.

Background:

Historically, freeways and their intersecting County roads were relatively simple. They consisted of freeways for vehicular travel, under- or over-crossings, and County roadway intersections. Identifying the basic elements for maintenance could be described and assigned by stating the State would maintain the freeway, on- and off-ramps and associated intersections, and structures over and under the freeway.

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The County would maintain the roadway surface and striping, as well as any ancillary features like County roadway signs, pedestrian paths, etc.

With the current 101 widening and parallel projects there are many new features that require more definition about maintenance responsibilities. These include things like pedestrian walkways, roundabouts, landscaping, drainage systems that include biofiltration, lighting, and decorative elements. Approving a Superseding Freeway Agreement will allow vital parallel projects to proceed.

This agreement covers improvements planned or constructed by County, State, and SBCAG as part of the Highway 101 HOV/Rehabilitation Project and the parallel Coastal Access Improvements projects:

- Highway 101 HOV/Rehabilitation (State)
- Via Real Coastal Trail Enhancements (County)
- Santa Claus Lane Streetscape Improvements Project (County)
- Santa Claus Lane Bike Path Project (SBCAG)
- Wallace Ave Summerland Coastal Access Improvements Project (County)
- Padaro Lane Summerland Coastal Access Improvements Project (County)
- Sheffield Ave Undercrossing (State)
- Posilipo Lane Southbound Onramp (State)
- San Ysidro Roundabout and Olive Mill Roundabout Project (SBCAG/State)

The Freeway Maintenance Agreements with Caltrans is before your Board as a separate agenda item.
