
CEOA NOTICE OF EXEMPTION



TO: Santa Barbara County Clerk of the Board of Supervisors

FROM: General Services Department, Real Property Division

The following activity is determined to be exempt from further environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, as defined in the State and County Guidelines for the implementation of CEQA.

LOCATION: The approximately 9,344 sq. ft. northerly thirty (30) foot wide portion of a sixty (60) foot wide County road, ingress and egress easement interest located on a portion of that certain real property known as County Assessor's Parcel Number 073-440-026, situated at Storke Road and Frey Way in the City of Goleta, in the County of Santa Barbara.

PROJECT TITLE: Proposed Summary Vacation of an approximately 9,344 sq. ft. northerly thirty (30) foot wide portion of a sixty (60) foot wide County road easement interest located on a portion of that certain real property known as County Assessor's Parcel Number 073-440-026, situated at Storke Road and Frey Way in the City of Goleta, in the County of Santa Barbara; Third District.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Proposed Summary Vacation of an approximately 9,344 sq. ft. northerly thirty (30) foot wide portion of a sixty (60) foot wide County road easement interest located on a portion of that certain real property known as County Assessor's Parcel Number 073-440-026, situated at Storke Road and Frey Way in the City of Goleta, in Santa Barbara County. The purpose of summarily vacating the subject easement interest is to remove the County's interest in and liability for such excess, unused, and unneeded road, ingress and egress easement interest. and to allow the fee owner of the property burdened by said easement to remove such encumbrance from title to their property.

Reasons to support exemption findings: The Santa Barbara County's proposed summary vacation of the excess and unused portion of an easement interest is a paper transaction that will not result in any physical impacts or changes to the environment. The easement interest to be vacated is excess, unused, and unneeded for County road purposes and uses. The proposed summary vacation will not in and of itself result in any changes to the land.



NOTICE

Each project applicant shall remit to the county clerk the environmental filing fee before or at the time of filing a Notice of Determination (Pub. Resources Code, § 21152; Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subdivision (d); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 753.5). Without the appropriate fee, statutory or categorical exemption, or a valid No Effect Determination issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), the Notice of Determination is not operative, vested, or final, and shall not be accepted by the county clerk.

COUNTY DOCUMENTARY HANDLING FEE

The county clerk may charge a documentary handling fee of fifty dollars (\$50) per filing in addition to the environmental filing fee (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (e); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 753.5, subd. (g)(1)). A county board of supervisors shall have the authority to increase or decrease the fee or charge, that is otherwise authorized to be levied by another provision of law, in the amount reasonably necessary to recover the cost of providing any product or service or the cost of enforcing any regulation for which the fee or charge is levied (Gov. Code, § 54985, subd. (a)).

COLLECTION PROCEDURES FOR COUNTY GOVERNMENTS

	 Notice of Determination (NOD): Collect environmental filing fee or copy of previously issued cash receipt. (Do not collect fee if project applicant presents a No Effect Determination signed by CDFW. An additional fee is required for each separate environmental document. An addendum is not considered a separate environmental document. Checks should be made payable to the county.) Issue cash receipt to project applicant. Attach copy of cash receipt and, if applicable, previously issued cash receipt, to NOD. Mail filing fees for CRP document to CDFW prior to filing the NOD or equivalent final approval (Cal. Code Regs. Tit. 14, § 753.5 (b)(5)). The CRP should request receipt from CDFW to show proof of payment for filing the NOD or equivalent approval. Please mail payment to address below made attention to the Cash Receipts Unit of the Accounting Services Branch.

Within 30 days after the end of each month in which the environmental filing fees are collected, each county shall summarize and record the amount collected on the monthly State of California Form No. CA25 (TC31) and remit the amount collected to the State Treasurer. Identify the remittance on Form No. CA25 as "Environmental Document Filing Fees" per Fish and Game Code section 711.4.

The county clerk shall mail the following documents to CDFW on a monthly basis:

- A photocopy of the monthly State of California Form No. CA25 (TC31)
- CDFW/ASB copies of all cash receipts (including all voided receipts)
- A copy of all CDFW No Effect Determinations filed in lieu of fee payment
- A copy of all NODs filed with the county during the preceding month
- A list of the name, address and telephone number of all project applicants for which an NOD has been filed. If this information is contained on the cash receipt filed with CDFW under California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 753.5, subdivision (e)(6), no additional information is required.

DOCUMENT RETENTION

The county shall retain two copies of the cash receipt (for lead agency and county clerk) and a copy of all documents described above for at least 12 months.

RECEIPT NUMBER

- # The first two digits automatically populate by making the appropriate selection in the County/State Agency of Filing drop down menu.
- The next eight digits automatically populate when a date is entered.
- The last three digits correspond with the sequential order of issuance for each calendar year. For example, the first receipt number issued on January 1 should end in 001. If a county issued 252 receipts for the year ending on December 31, the last receipt number should end in 252. CDFW recommends that counties and state agencies 1) save a local copy of this form, and 2) track receipt numbers on a spreadsheet tabbed by month to ensure accuracy.

DO NOT COMBINE THE ENVIRONMENTAL FEES WITH THE STATE SHARE OF FISH AND WILDLIFE FEES.
