I have a lifelong passion for open space and trails. Now that I'm retired, I have the time to apply my interest and experience to protect and expand the trails network in Santa Barbara County. Earlier in my career I was a principal/partner in a landscape architecture firm in Monterey CA where I developed an expertise in park, open space, and trail master planning and design. My clients included cities, counties, and park and open space districts. After living in Monterey for					

20 years, my wife and I moved to Kauai, HI, where I was the Transportation Planner for the County of Kauai. I planned and designed bicycle and pedestrian networks to facilitate safe walking and biking, facilitated community engagement, and coordinated with multiple state and county agencies. After 10 years on Kauai, we moved to Orcutt in September 2022. We are grateful to now live in Santa Barbara County and enjoy the trails near our home nearly every day.

Recreational trails that not only connect people to nature, but also have a transportation function, are of added community benefit. In addition to my work experience with trails, much of my volunteer experience has been with neighborhood programs to develop the capacity of youth and families to contribute to improving neighborhoods and communities.
