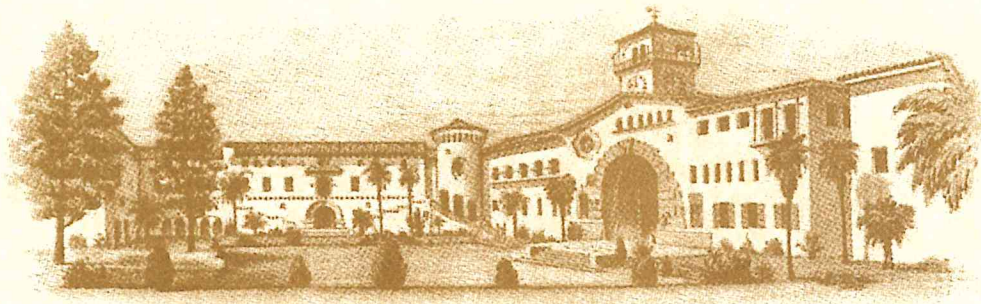

*Whereas, survivors of domestic violence often face physical, emotional, and psychological trauma, and it is crucial to provide support and resources to help them rebuild their lives; and*

*Whereas, promoting awareness and education about domestic violence is essential in preventing future instances of abuse and fostering a society that values respect, empathy, and healthy relationships; and*

*Whereas, here in Santa Barbara County, Domestic Violence Solutions (DVS), a premier not-for-profit organization, that provides safety, shelter, and support countywide for individuals and families affected by domestic violence and collaborates with community partners to raise awareness regarding the cause, prevalence and impact of domestic violence, will be organizing a series of community events and encourages all to take part in raising awareness about domestic violence and the ways we can all contribute towards its prevention.*




