## **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a Funding Agreement with Southern California Edison Company for Mission Canyon Trailhead Improvements in the amount of \$214,200 with approximate local matching funds of \$75,000; and
- b) Determine the proposed actions are for the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that which presently exists, and that the proposed action is therefore exempt from California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR 15301(c), and approve and direct staff to file the attached Notice of Exemption on that basis.

#### **Summary Text:**

This item is on the agenda to authorize a Funding Agreement with Southern California Edison (SCE) for Mission Canyon Trailhead Improvements. SCE will voluntarily pay the Public Works Transportation Department \$214,200 for improvements at and around Tunnel Trail trailhead. Improvements agreed upon were generated from recommendations by neighbors and include enhanced parking along Tunnel Rd, vegetation maintenance along the east side of the road, and a pedestrian path.

#### **Background:**

Tunnel Trail is one of the most popular hiking trails on the South Coast of Santa Barbara County. The trail is located in the unincorporated community of Mission Canyon and all parking for the trail is limited to the shoulders of Tunnel Road, which is maintained by the County.

On January 16, 2020, the County issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) to SCE pertaining to unauthorized grading SCE performed on the Access Road near Tunnel Trail in December 2019. In response to the activities subject to the NOV, SCE performed repairs and cleanup on and around the access road near Tunnel Trail and will perform a proposed Mission Canyon Stream Habitat Restoration Project, which is undergoing a separate review process in accordance with pending County approvals. Restoration activities include restoration of the stream hydrology and habitat features, remediate tree impacts within Mission Creek, stabilize creek banks and slopes, and restore habitat. Impacts to native trees will be remediated and tree mitigation is also proposed to account for impacts from previous grading activities. These NOV Responsive Projects are a direct response to the Notice of Violation issued by the County.

In addition to, and separate from, these NOV Responsive Projects, SCE voluntarily completed or funded, or is committed to fund, multiple projects requested by the community to improve access to and recreational experiences on the Tunnel Trail. Projects identified are aimed to improve parking and pedestrian safety on Tunnel Road. Trailhead improvements include County Projects #1-4 listed in Attachment A: Exhibit B. The City of Santa Barbara is poised to enter into a similar agreement with SCE in the amount of \$85,800 for improvements at the trailhead, which is identified as City Project #5 in the Funding Agreement.

County Project #1	Improve parking area above 1404 Tunnel Rd.
	Paving, striping and limited retaining or curb structure on canyon side of the
	parking spaces. Possible addition of one or two parking spaces.
County Project #2	Pedestrian safety. On East side of road, prune and maintain brush back to fence line. Starting above the gabion wall located about 75 feet below driveway to 1440 Tunnel, where slope allows, move fence out to create pedestrian path. From driveway at 1440, continuing up to Orange Grove Ave, regrade, move rocks and adapt drainage to create a pathway. Possible alternate in this area is use of timber walkway.
County	Eliminate Parking above 1340 Tunnel Rd.
Project #3	Eliminate 1 or 2 parking spaces to include retention structures to improve
	marginal spaces into full parking, as well as improve/add one or two spaces on opposite side of the street.
County	Create parking where possible.
Project #4	Paving, diagonal striping, possibly curb at the parking area about 200 feet past the
	hairpin turn at 1297 Tunnel Rd. Possible addition of two parking spaces.
City Project #5	Improvements at Trailhead.
