- A. Whereas on January 7, 1980, by Resolution No. 80-12, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Land Use Plan;
- B. Whereas on July 19, 1982, by Ordinance No. 3312, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance (CZO), Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code;
- C. Whereas on November 7, 2023, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara approved an amendment to the County's Local Coastal Program by amending the CZO, Article II of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code, regarding Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) and Minor Ordinance Amendments (Ordinance No. 5194, Case No. 23ORD-00009);
- D. Whereas the Board of Supervisors held duly noticed public hearings, as required by Sections 65355 and 65856 of the Government Code, on the amendments referenced above, at which the amendments were explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance;
- E. Whereas these amendments to the Local Coastal Program are consistent with the provisions of the Coastal Act of 1976, the Santa Barbara County Coastal Land Use Plan, and the requirements of State planning and zoning laws as amended to this date; and
- F. The Board of Supervisors now wishes to submit these amendments to the California Coastal Commission for certification.

## NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The above recitations are true and correct.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 65358 and 65857 of the Government Code and Section 30514 of the Public Resources Code, the above described changes have been adopted as an amendment to the Santa Barbara County Local Coastal Program.
- 3. The Board of Supervisors certifies that these amendments are intended to be carried out in a manner fully in conformity with the California Coastal Act.
