- Identify criteria and ensure projects fit criteria
- Identify estimated cost for each project and screen for cost threshold





Community Project Funding Appropriations Deadlines: March-April

- Limited number of projects submitted to each Senator/ Congressman
- Require demonstrated community support for project ex) letters of support from elected community leaders
- Approximate cost range per project: \$500,000 \$2M
- From the list, 7-10 projects selected for submission by Federal Lobbyist and County staff based on project alignment with committee guidelines
