Thanks for being so respectful and responsive during this process. I will most likely tune in electronically. I wish I had language to convey the impact of this project (either size) on our communities. I wish to convey the following points one last time:

1. Parking must be provided on site for the influx of vehicles that come with a project of this nature (Mr.Nelson stated part of the impact on parking was the type of driveway needed for emergency vehicles to access- ways to further mitigate this issue have been submitted following the town hall meeting), 2. Foster and Morning Ridge must be made safer and slower- we have petitioned for speed bumps and expanded (enforced) parking permits, 3. Consideration of a conversion to senior housing to further minimize the impact on traffic and noise- this was also supported at the town hall meeting.
