WHEREAS, upon promotion to Civil Engineer Manager on September 12, 1994, he oversaw and managed the completion of significant road, bridge, and drainage improvement projects throughout the County. Due to his high level of competency and experience, Scott was promoted to Deputy Public Works Director over the Transportation Division on March 6, 2000, and having demonstrated superior leadership skills, was promoted to Public Works Director on May 7, 2007; and

WHEREAS, as an executive, Scott was instrumental in recruiting talented staff, implementing beneficial policies, navigating the department through complex projects and over a dozen declared disasters, and preparing the County for current and future needs; and

WHEREAS, Scott is respected by his staff, County leadership, local and regional agency partners, community members, and all whom he comes in contact with, serving as president of both the County Engineers Association of California and the National Association of County Engineers, winning numerous personal and professional awards; and

WHEREAS, Scott's more than 35 years of commitment, knowledge, mentoring, experience, and camaraderie that he frequently shares with colleagues and acquaintances alike will be greatly missed. Scott's wife Ruth, son Samuel, and daughter Sarah, have supported him throughout his career, and look forward to having him around when he isn't golfing.
