Recommended Actions:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement for Professional Legal Services with Rimôn, P.C., extending the term to September 14, 2026 and adding \$40,000, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$115,000; and
- b) Determine that the above actions are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15378(b)(5) of the CEQA Guidelines, because they consist of administrative activities of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

Summary Text: From time to time, the County has a need to engage outside counsel to assist the County and its elected officials with bankruptcy matters. This Amendment No. 2 extends the term of an existing outside counsel agreement to September 14, 2026 and adds \$40,000, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$115,000. The attorney primarily responsible for performing the bankruptcy legal services is Jacquelyn Choi.
