Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors approve the attached proposed amendments to the Conflicts of Interest Code of the Santa Barbara County Employees Retirement System ("SBCERS").

Summary Text:

SBCERS adopted the attached amendments to its Conflicts of Interest Code on May 23, 2012. The amendments clarify which designated positions manage public investments for purposes of Section 87200 of the Government Code. Minutes of the action taken to amend SBCERS' Conflict of Interest Code is attached.

Background:

All public agencies are required by the Political Reform Act of 1974 to:

- 1. Adopt local conflicts of interest codes identifying the reporting requirements of covered employees; and
- 2. Review the need for any revisions to their local conflicts of interest codes at least every two years.

The Board of Supervisors is the "code reviewing body" for the SBCERS's Conflict of Interest Code. Government Code Section 87303. Thus, SBCERS's Conflict of Interest Code is not effective until approved by the Board of Supervisors.
