Justification: This budget revision will increase revenue, expenditure and operating transfer budget appropriations in Housing and Community Development (HCD) Fund

0064 CDBG Federal for various Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) projects as previously approved by the Board of Supervisors in the annual action plan process. The County has received funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Revenues, expenditures and operating transfers are budgeted in the Housing and Community Development Division of Community Services in Fund 0064 CDBG Federal. This fiscal year, HCD has been able to process over \$1.5 million dollars for CDBG projects. It is expected that an additional \$835,381 will be spent by June 30, 2013. This includes projects re-budgeted from FY 2011-12 in addition to projects budgeted for FY 2012-13. This action will increase LIAcct 4789 (Federal-Other) by \$885,612 and LIAcct 7671 by \$835,381. LIAcct 7901 will increase by \$50,231 offset by LIAcct 5911 Fund 0001 with an offsetting increase of \$50,231. This will enable processing of payments to projects such as public service and capital projects in the cities of Lompoc, Carpinteria, Buellton and Solvang, including County capital projects managed by the General Services Department, as listed on the

attached summary spreadsheet.
