

81% of California's pavements are owned by cities and counties



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



Future options for Santa Barbara County – Modeled after other local agencies with similar funding shortfalls:

- Concentrate funding on high-volume, backbone roads
- Discontinue surface treatments on residential roads – corrective maintenance only
- Prioritize roads for removal from the maintained system





- B. Adopt a Resolution supporting the findings of the California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment and urging the State to identity a sufficient and stable funding source for local street and road maintenance and rehabilitation.
- C. If the Resolution is adopted, authorize the Chair to sign letters addressed to the Governor and local State Legislators urging them to identity a sufficient and stable funding source for local street and road maintenance and rehabilitation.
