

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO VACATE COUNTY ROAD RIGHT OF WAY.
PORTIONS OF RAILWAY AVENUE, SANTA BARBARA AVENUE AND AN UNNAMED
ALLEY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LOS OLIVOS**

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Barbara (herein "COUNTY") is the holder of the right-of-way commonly identified as Railway Avenue, Santa Barbara Avenue and an unnamed alley all in the township of Los Olivos in the unincorporated area of the County of Santa Barbara, State of California. The referenced right-of-way (herein the "Portion") is shown on the Map of the Town of Los Olivos, filed in the Santa Barbara County Recorder's Office on February 8, 1888 in Rack 3, Map 6; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the vacation of the Portion is in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the beneficiary of the right of way vacation has agreed to allow continued public use of Railway Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the right to reopen Railway Avenue as a vehicular or non-vehicular public trail is being reserved from the proposed right of way vacation; and

WHEREAS, the rights of all existing public utilities to use the Portion shall also be reserved from the vacation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

That the proceedings for the proposed right-of-way vacation are being conducted in accordance with California Streets and Highway Code 8320 et. seq.; and

That an exhibit showing the proposed area to be declared excess to County needs and vacated is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A"; and

That the right to construct future vehicular and non-vehicular public trails shall be reserved from the proposed vacation; and

That the rights of existing utility companies install, replace and maintain utilities within the Portion shall be reserved from the proposed vacation; and

That the **2nd day of July, 2013, at 9:00 a.m.**, or shortly thereafter, in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors, 105 East Anapamu, 4th Floor, Santa Barbara, California, is hereby fixed as the time and place for the hearing of the Resolution of an Order to Vacate, at which time and place any party may appear and be heard relative to said proposed declaration.
