BACKGROUND



- Existing Stormwater Ordinance Adopted by Board of Supervisors in 2007
 - ➤ County Code Article IV of Chapter 29
- Required Under
 - ➤ Clean Water Act NPDES Phase II Program (Finalized 1999)
 - ➤ State Phase II Municipal General Permit (Reissued 2013)
 - ➤ County Stormwater Management Program (Approved 2006)
- Protects County's Storm Drain System
 - Prohibits polluted discharges to County system
 - Establishes authority to enforce the ordinance



REASON FOR AMENDMENT



- Comply with State Water Resources Control Board Order 2013-0001
 - ➤ Certify that County has legal authority to control pollutant discharges and meet all requirements of the Municipal General Permit
 - > Prohibit non-incidental irrigation runoff
- Comply with Regional Board Resolution No. 2013-0032
 - ➤ Post-Construction Stormwater Management Requirements for Development Projects in the Central Coast Region (effective March 2014)
- Ordinance Amendments necessary to establish authority to implement and be in compliance with new NPDES stormwater requirements



RECOMMENDED ACTIONS



- Consider introduction of ordinance amending the Stormwater Management and Discharge Control Ordinance (Attachment A)
- Set hearing on February 11, 2014 to consider adoption of the ordinance amendment (Administrative Agenda)
