
## Paradiso: Significant Impacts



Harard on a small wave at LL CAPTTAN point. [Gary Connelly]


There are two distinct breaks.

- NAPLES REEF is a shoal shown on U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey maps as being nine-tenths of a mile from shore and 2½ fathoms (15 feet) deep. Thick peaks appear here during strong winter swells; they must be 10-12 feet to break at all and probably can reach 20.
- NAPLES BEACH—During smaller swells good peaks break along a mile of coastline located inshore from Naples Reef.

Tiny village of Naples is 13 miles west of Santa Barbara and 4 miles east of El Capitan.

Maples. Surf about 4-5 feet along Naples Beach. Naples Reef is not breaking; if it were, white water would be seen in lower right corner. Railroad track (complete with freight train) is between Highway 101 and coast.
