#### SUMMARY ORDER TO VACATE and QUITCLAIM (PORTION OF AN UNUSED RIGHT-OF-WAY)

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Barbara (herein "COUNTY") is the holder of the right-of-way in the township of Los Olivos in the unincorporated area of the County of Santa Barbara, State of California. The referenced right-of-way is shown on the Map of the Town of Los Olivos, filed in the Santa Barbara County Recorder's Office on February 8, 1888 in Rack 3, Map 6; and

WHEREAS, the above referenced Map includes an unnamed alley (herein the "Alley") located in Block 43, which alley was never constructed and is outside the improved and traveled roadway, and the County has no plans to use or develop the Alley for public use; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Alley (the "Portion") is located on parcel 135-210-014 and the owner of that parcel has requested the vacation and quitclaim of the Portion; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 8331(a) of the California Streets and Highways Code, for a period of five (5) consecutive years, the Alley has been impassable for vehicular travel, and is therefore eligible for summary vacation; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 8334(a) of the California Streets and Highways Code, the Public Works Department has determined that the Alley is excess right of way not required for street or highway purposes, is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and is therefore eligible for summary vacation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Streets & Highways Code section 8334.5 it has been determined that there are no in-place public utility facilities in the Alley which will be affected by the vacation and therefore it is entitled to a Summary Vacation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 892(a) of the Streets and Highways Code the Santa Barbara County Public Works Department has determined that no part of the Alley is necessary for present or prospective public use as a nonmotorized transportation facility (as defined in Section 887 of the Streets and Highway Code); and

WHEREAS, vacation of the Alley will not impair public or private access; and

WHEREAS, vacation of the Alley will not affect existing or future traffic circulation; and

WHEREAS, the date of the Board action of the proposed right of way vacation was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the County; and

WHEREAS, vacation of the Alley is in the public interest, in that the County will be relieved of liability for the vacated area; and

WHEREAS, at the Planning Commission hearing of December 4, 2013, the Planning Commission found the abandonment of the Alley to be in conformity with the County's General Plan pursuant to Government Code Section 65402(a).

- 1. That the above recitals are true and correct; and
- 2. That the Portion of the unnamed Alley proposed for vacation and quitclaim is located on Santa Barbara County Assessor parcel number 135-210-014 and is shown on "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated herein; and
- 3. That the Portion is hereby summarily vacated as County right-of-way pursuant to the above referenced California Streets and Highways Code Sections; and

- 4. That the County does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim all right, title and interest to the Portion as depicted on Exhibit A attached hereto; and
- 5. That this Resolution, attested to by the Clerk of the Board under the seal of the Board, shall be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, and that the date of recording shall become the effective date of this Summary Order to Vacate and Quitclaim; and
- 6. The intent of this Summary Order to Vacate and Quitclaim is to remove the right-of-way burdening the subject parcel and does not create any separate legal parcel(s) within the meaning of the California Civil Code Section 1093, nor any separate units of real property within the California Subdivision Map Act.
- 7. From and after the effective date, the Portion vacated no longer constitutes a public right-of-way.


